



The Rectangular Rhythm Sketch

Note: This is a great layout to use 6" x 6" paper packets.

Cutting Directions:

Legend: All dimensions are width x height (W x H).

1. Base Cardstock (French Vanilla):

- (2) 11.75" x 11.5" for page bases.
- (1) 5.25" x 2.25"
- (1) 2.5" x .75

2. Patterned Paper (Timeless Plaid):

- (6) 3.25" x 4.25" for left page accents
- (3) Additional pieces in varying sizes for banners and accents (e.g., 1.25" x 3", 1.75" x 2.5").
- 3. Solid Cardstock (Pecan Pie):
 - (7) 3.25" x 4.25".
 - (1) 3.25" x 3.25".
 - (1) 2.75" x 1".
- 4. Chipboard (Optional):
 - (2) Strips, 0.25" x 12", for spacing guides.

Preparation

1. Stamping:

• Choose and stamp images for your theme (e.g., mushrooms, flowers, critters). Cut or punch shapes as needed.

2. Photo Mats:

• Attach photos to mats. Add ribbon to some for extra detail.

Assembly Instructions

- 1. Left Page:
 - Arrange and adhere patterned paper pieces to create a grid design, leaving a 0.25" gap between each piece.
 - Add photos and embellishments, using foam tape for dimension where needed.
 - Include title and subtitle using stamped images or die cuts.

2. Right Page:

- Repeat the grid design for consistency.
- Create a hidden journaling pocket using foam tape and a journaling card.
- Add clusters of embellishments and banners for interest.
- 3. Final Touches:
 - Add embellishments like sequins or dots to tie the design together.

Tips for Personalization

- Swap colors and patterns to fit your chosen theme.
- Use different stamps or dies to create a custom look.
- Play with layouts—try rotating or flipping the sketch.
